## Fabric requirements for Whizz Bang blocks

- Depending on how scrappy you would like your blocks to be: choose 10-25 fabrics. These can be 4 in strips cut across the fabric, cut from fat quarters or raid your scraps.

Choose fabrics with small prints -stripes, dots and spots, tone on tone, solids, geometric, small florals. Include light to dark fabrics and contrasting colours. Solids and tone on tone fabrics are great for breaking up patterned fabrics.

You don't have to use bright colours, these blocks look beautiful in soft, pretty colours too! And other styles of fabrics like Civil War repro, batiks, 30 's prints, old shirts. You can use a Jelly Roll as long as you add in extra contrasting fabric.

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- 2 yards, neutral coloured fabric for the circle foundations, this will be covered.
- Optional - Picture fabrics - we can work with any size.
- $1 / 2$ yd fusible interfacing
- Bias strips: $10 y d s$ of $11 / 2$ in wide bias strip, unfolded, for the circle edges. We use approximately 1 yd per block, in case you would like to use different coloured bindings. Or make your own strips from 1yd
- Freezer Paper: 2 yards

Backgrounds \& Quilt requirements: depend on the style of quilt you are wanting to make. Bring a selection of what you might like to use, or email Rachaeldaisy to discuss this at:

Rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat
Small craft iron and ironing mat if you have one
Compass for drawing circles

Fabric scissors, (Karen Kay Buckley's Perfect Scissors are excellent)
Paper scissors
Neutral-coloured thread
Clear Monofilament thread
Good sharp pins
General sewing supplies
