Materials List

Composing Quilts with Anna Maria

Fabrics:

-2 fat quarters each of 6 different (printed- any style) color categories: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple

-Please note you will be swapping these, but don't leave the good stuff at home! And don't forget the range of light and dark versions of all the colors :)

-Any other fabrics you have been dying to quilt with! From fat quarters of color, to yards of more tonal background ideas and everything in between

-(Optionally) In advance of class Anna Maria will share private online shop links to some "quilt starter" kits that could be used on their own, or combined with your favorites

-Any orphan blocks or panels you would like to give a home in your project

-Two 18" squares of fabric, and batting (quilt sandwich) to practice hand quilting techniques (you can bring patchwork for this)

Tools:

-favorite cutting tools and grids

-favorite templates for designing patchwork or applique ([Anna Maria has several](#))

-a yard (or more) of [Pellon 805](#) (Wonder Under) if you prefer raw edge applique

-a box of aluminum foil sheets (yes from the grocery)

-favorite threads for machine sewing, hand sewing, and hand quilting ([Anna Maria uses Aurifil 50wt and 12wt](#))

-[Sewline Glue Stick](#)

-straight pins

-hand sewing needles - (Anna Maria uses a range of embroidery needles to accommodate various thickness of thread)

-pencil & notebook- graph paper is great!
