

## SUPPLIES:

### **DYE with Malka:**

Containers (think jars or food containers)  
Measuring spoons (1/8 teaspoon-1 tablespoon)  
Measuring cup  
Apron  
Dust mask  
Gloves  
6 Styrofoam trays (or any mostly flat container with a lip that can be used as a palette)  
Extra foam brushes (optional if ordering the kit)

### **KIT \$55 plus shipping\*\***

(The kit will be sent to your homes prior to the workshop OR sent to Madeline Island if you prefer.)

2 yards cotton muslin  
3, 2 ounce jars of Procion MX dyes in your choice of colors (kit will include pre-selected colors)  
1 1/2 cup of Urea  
Soda ash (1-2 cups)  
2 foam brushes

### **DANCING with Irene**

Sewing Machine and all supplies associated with quilting  
Pins (for piecing and pinning fabric to design board)  
Rotary cutter  
Batting or flannel 6'x7' to cover design wall  
Cutting mat  
Extra fabric (1 yd black and 1 yd white)

### **STITCH with Carson\***

#### **Sewing Machine and all supplies associated with quilting, including:**

- Walking foot and/or free motion foot
- Needle for basting layers together (pins if you prefer)
- Assorted quilting thread. Consider bringing different weights as well as a variety of colors.
- Acrylic quilting ruler with markings
- Quilting gloves
- Hand-quilting supplies (if this is something you do)
- Dritz Point Turner & Seam Creaser (or similar tool)
- Marking Tool (i.e., hera tool, water soluble marker, fine point chalk pen, or other removable marking pen) You only need one way of marking designs, bring the tool(s) you like to use.
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper

#### **Fabric and Batting:**

- Backing material for your quilt (1 Yard)

- Batting for your quilt (min. 4" bigger than top)
- Extra backing fabric and batting to use for small samples. Plan for (3) 12" or smaller samples.

**Other Supplies:**

- Masking or painters' tape (any width)
- Clear tape (for taping tracing paper together)
- Scissors for paper
- Regular Graphite Pencil – dull is good.
- Pencil Sharpener
- Roll of Tracing Paper - Sheets of tracing paper are not large enough and are more expensive than a roll. 30" wide rolls are ideal, but you can purchase smaller width rolls and tape sections together.
- Colored pencils and felt tip markers (non-smelly please) for sketching ideas on tracing paper.

\*\*If you already own these items or want to purchase them yourself, you do not need to order the kit.

\*Carson will send a video prior to the class that will explain some items on the supply list. Some items are optional – she recommends watching the video before purchasing new supplies.
