



During this workshop we will be exploring the possibilities of using all our orphan blocks and pieces left over from other projects and turning them into a masterpiece.

OR you can start making your own sampler style quilt using one of my patterns: Delilah, Green Tea & Sweet Beans, Long Time Gone or any blocks from the range of Tempters.

I encourage people to bring UFP's with them to build upon but participants are also welcome to begin a brand new project & to learn tips and tricks for hand piecing.

Please bring to class

- Your chosen pattern or templates and fabric requirements for said chosen project

OR

- All your orphan blocks

PLUS

- A variety of small cuts of fabric- remember to include some florals, geometrics, spots, stripes, backgrounds etc. scraps, fat 1/16ths and eighths work well (and more is always better 😊😊)
- Quarter inch graph paper
- Thick template plastic- a thicker one works best (or pattern specific acrylic template set)
- Ultra fine permanent marker
- Scissors for cutting plastic
- Fabric scissors
- Straw or milliners needles size 11
- Neutral 50 wt cotton thread to blend with fabrics for piecing e.g. grey
- 50wt or 80wt cotton thread for appliqué in a variety of colours if applicable (You might like to add some Applique to your project)
- General sewing requirements eg pins, quick unpick, ruler etc.
- 0.7mm Mechanical pencil (propelling pencil) with 2B lead
- ¼" simple seam wheel (optional)
- Sandpaper board
