

# **DYE, DANCE, STITCH SUPPLIES:**

#### **DYE with Malka:**

- Pro print paste SH. Here's a link to where it can be purchased, though I will include 1 cup of this in the kits: <a href="https://prochemicalanddye.com/product/pro-print-paste-mix-sh/">https://prochemicalanddye.com/product/pro-print-paste-mix-sh/</a>
- Squeeze bottles, variety of bushes (bristle, foam) in different sizes
- This item is a bit more squishy, but tools for stamping, essentially anything with a flat surface that the student thinks can impress an image.
- Apron
- Dust mask
- Gloves

2 yards cotton muslin

3, 2 ounce jars of Procion MX dyes in your choice of colors (kit will include pre-selected colors)

1 1/2 cup of Urea

Soda ash (1-2 cups)

2 foam brushes

## **DANCING (Improv Quilting zoom with Irene)**

- Sewing Machine and all supplies associated with quilting (sewing machine rental available)
- Pins (for piecing and pinning fabric to design board)
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Extra fabric (1 yd black and 1 yd white)

## **STITCH with Carson\***

## Sewing Machine and all supplies associated with quilting, including:

- Walking foot and/or free motion foot
- Needle for basting layers together (pins if you prefer)
- Assorted quilting thread. Consider bringing different weights as well as a variety of colors.
- Acrylic quilting ruler with markings
- Quilting gloves
- Hand-quilting supplies (if this is something you do)
- Dritz Point Turner & Seam Creaser (or similar tool)
- Marking Tool (i.e., hera tool, water soluble marker, fine point chalk pen, or other removable marking pen) You only need one way of marking designs, bring the tool(s) you like to use.

- Thread snips
- Seam ripper

#### **Fabric and Batting:**

- Backing material for your quilt (1 Yard)
- Batting for your quilt (min. 36x 36)
- Extra backing fabric and batting to use for small samples. Plan for (3) 12" samples.

## **Other Supplies:**

- Masking or painters' tape (any width)
- Clear tape (for taping tracing paper together)
- Regular Graphite Pencil dull is good.
- Pencil Sharpener
- 12" Roll of Tracing Paper
- Colored pencils and felt tip markers (non-smelly please) for sketching ideas on tracing paper.
- eraser <a href="https://www.dickblick.com/products/staedtler-mars-plastic-erasers/">https://www.dickblick.com/products/staedtler-mars-plastic-erasers/</a> (or similar eraser designed for removing pencil from tracing paper, velum or drafting film) The eraser doesn't need to be this exact brand, there are several that will do.
