

Appliqué in Santa Fe with Denyse Schmidt Material List

Materials

- Bring a selection of quilting weight fabrics for your background (a single fabric or color works best), and for your motifs. I suggest quilting cottons.
 - 4-5 yards background fabric in a single color
 - 3-4 yards of motif fabric. Can be a single color for a strong graphic result, or a range of textures, prints and colors. You know best how you work—if you want options and extra for trial and error, bring more!

& Tools

- fabric scissors
- snips
- rotary cutter/mat/6x24 inch gridded ruler
- fabric-marking pencils for both light and dark fabrics
- drawing pencils or pens
- applique glue stick (with a couple of refills)
- camera (or smart phone)
- your preferred thimble(s) for hand-stitching
- appliqué thread to match your motif fabric(s). (I suggest a 60-80 wt thread. The higher the number, the thinner the thread.)
- sketchbook/notebook
