Tools

Journal and pencil for drawing

Freezer paper

Needles - #10 and 11 short darning - #24 and #18 Chenille - #3, #1 and #15 Milliners - 24 and #20 Tapestry

Aurifil #2375 Antique Pink thread for piecing and 60 wt. Efini cotton thread for cotton appliqué

12wt Ellana wool thread for wool appliqué

Appliqué pins

Bohin pencil glue stick

Embroidery, paper and fabric scissors

Thick template plastic

Ultra fine permanent marker

Jen Kingwell 0.7mm Mechanical pencil with 2B lead (USA)

1/4" simple seam wheel

Sandpaper board

If you own bring Yo-yo templates - English paper pieces - Looms

Helpful: personal light

Background

20" square hand dyed wool in a color of your choice for your background OR Half Yard of linen

Small pieces of cotton fabrics in the same color as the background wool for layering of your background

Appliqué

Hand dyed wool in a variety of colors for appliqué design

Assorted small pieces of textural fabrics including hand dyed silk velvet, silk and linen

1/4 yard Presto Sheer for stabilizing velvet

A variety of small cuts of fabric- remember to include some florals, geometrics, spots, stripes etc. in a range of colors or just your favorites. Scraps, fat 1/16ths and 1/8 work well

Embellishments

Embroidery and specialty threads in varying weights, fibers and textures.

Couching yarns, ribbons, rick rack and beads, buttons and sequins

Required Book

Sue's embroidery book, Creative Stitching

For Hand Quilting Techniques

18 inch quilt sandwich - 2 cotton fabrics and a piece of Quilters Dream Cotton Request batting Solid fabrics work well as it's easy to visualize your stitches. Chenille needles size 24 and 26

Perle thread 8 wt or Aurifil 12 wt

Basting safety pins or basting gun

Hoop optional (I don't use one)
