

Please bring to class

- Your chosen pattern it can be any one of my designs. I will provide a simple block for you to work on in class and an Applique design if you don't wish to to choose a project.
- A variety of small cuts of fabric- remember to include some florals, geometrics, spots, stripes etc. Scraps, fat 1/16ths and eighths work well (and more is always better 666)
- o A fat ¼ as a background for appliqué
- Thick template plastic
- Ultra-fine permanent marker
- Scissors for cutting plastic
- Fabric scissors
- Straw or milliners needles size 11
- Neutral colour 5 wt cotton thread to blend with fabrics for piecing e.g. grey
- o 50wt or 80wt thread for appliqué in a variety of colours
- o General sewing requirements e.g. pins, ruler etc.
- o 0.7mm Mechanical pencil (propelling pencil) with 2B or 2 lead (USA)
- o 1/4" Simple Seam Wheel (optional).
- Sandpaper board
- Notebook for notes
- o Show Me Your Tips (handbook of tips optional)

For Hand Quilting

18 inch (approx.) quilt sandwich. I.e. 2 fat quarters and a piece of batting cut to this size. Solid fabrics work well as it's easy to visualise your stitches. Make sure the batting is recommended for hand quilting e.g. Quilters Dream Cotton Request

Perle thread 8wt or Aurifil 12 wt

Chenille needles Size 26 (12wt thread) or 24 (8wt Thread)

Hoop optional (I don't use one)
