Background

For Mini Version - 20" square of hand dyed wool in a water color for your background Small pieces of cotton fabrics in the same color as the background wool for layering of your background

If piecing a background in class a sewing machine is required.

Appliqué

Hand dyed wool in a variety of colors for appliqué design Assorted small pieces of textural fabrics including cotton, hand dyed silk velvet, silk and linen 1/4 yard Presto Sheer for stabilizing velvet

Embellishments

Embroidery and specialty threads in varying weights, fibers and textures.
